Students can select courses from multiple specialties and general electives to help them develop the knowledge, skills, and attitudes needed to prepare them for their chosen career.

## Requirements for the Bachelor of Interdisciplinary Studies

To earn the Bachelor of Interdisciplinary Studies degree, students must complete the degree components listed below:

General Education Core 34 credits
Two Concentrations 30 credits
Capstone Project 6 credits
Electives 50 credits\*

Total: 120 credits

\*At least 24 elective credits must be upper division (300- or 400-level) courses

In order to earn the Bachelor of Interdisciplinary Studies degree, students must complete two 15-credit concentrations and two 3-credit capstone courses while achieving a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 in the concentration and capstone courses.
